Over the summer, you hopefully have been visiting colleges and doing research into possible schools to attend in September 2026 or beyond. The following is a suggested timeline for the remainder of the college search process:

September - November

- Identify schools that match your desire for a specific location, major, activity, etc.
- Visit the campus before applying to ensure that you will feel comfortable in that environment.
- Identify people to write letters of recommendation (typically a classroom teacher, counselor and other recommender like a coach, boss, volunteer coordinator, club advisor, etc.)
- Begin to brainstorm and formulate essay ideas.

October - late January

- Create a Common App account at https://www.commonapp.org/ if applicable.
- Complete applications.
- Request official transcript from the Counseling Office.
- Complete financial aid form(s).
