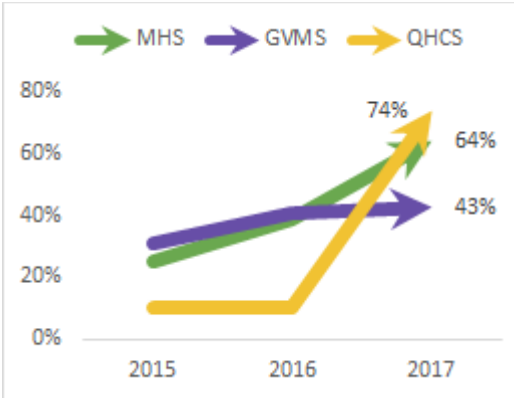
2018 MCAS Test Results

 (that means we performed better than **74%** of all Elementary and Middle Schools **IN THE STATE!**)

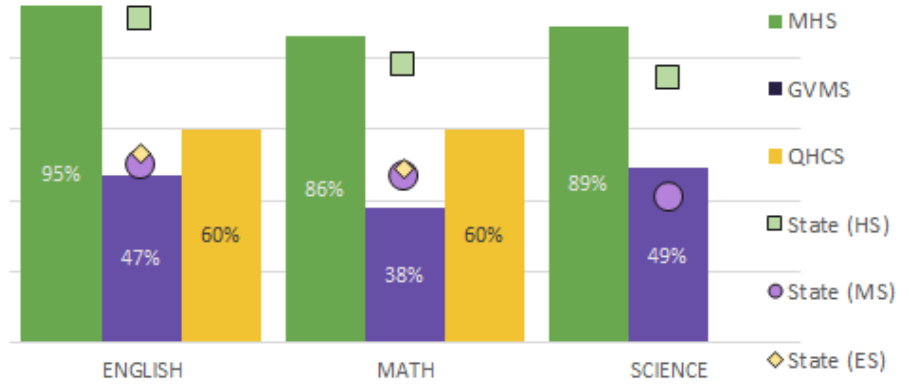
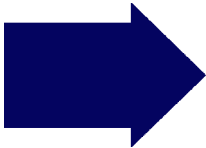
